What took so long?

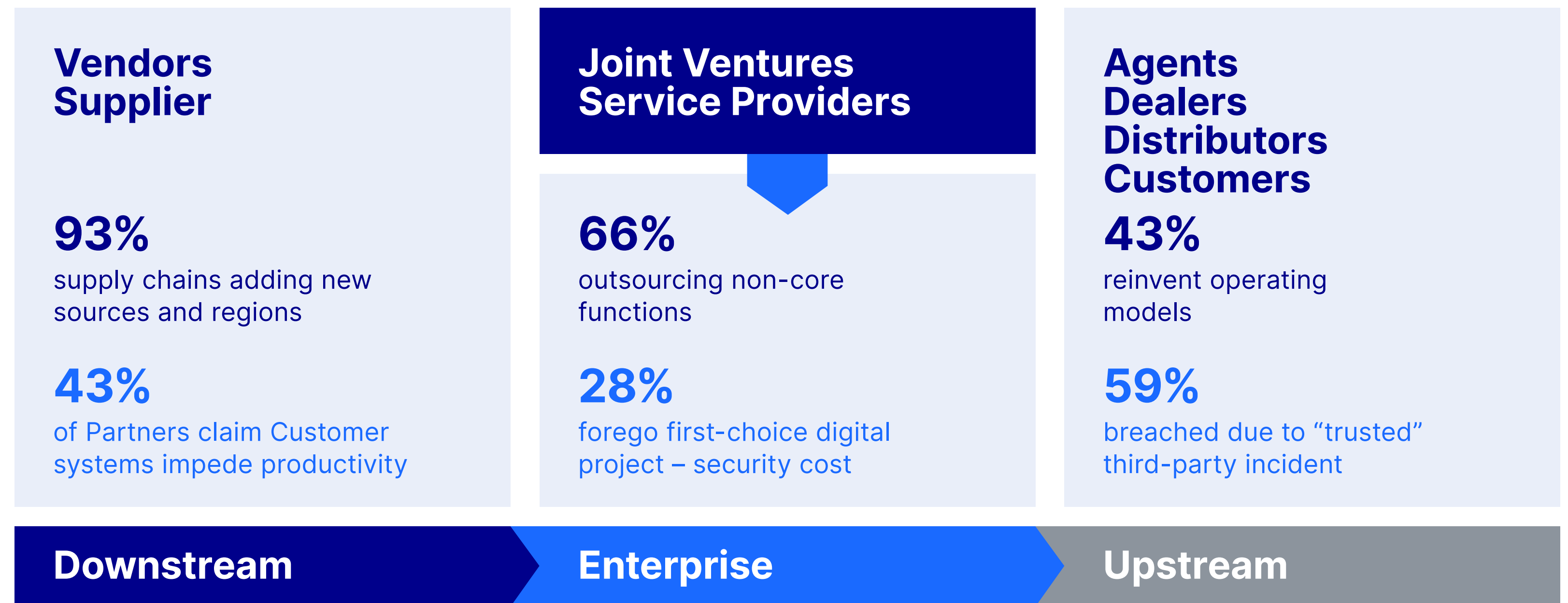

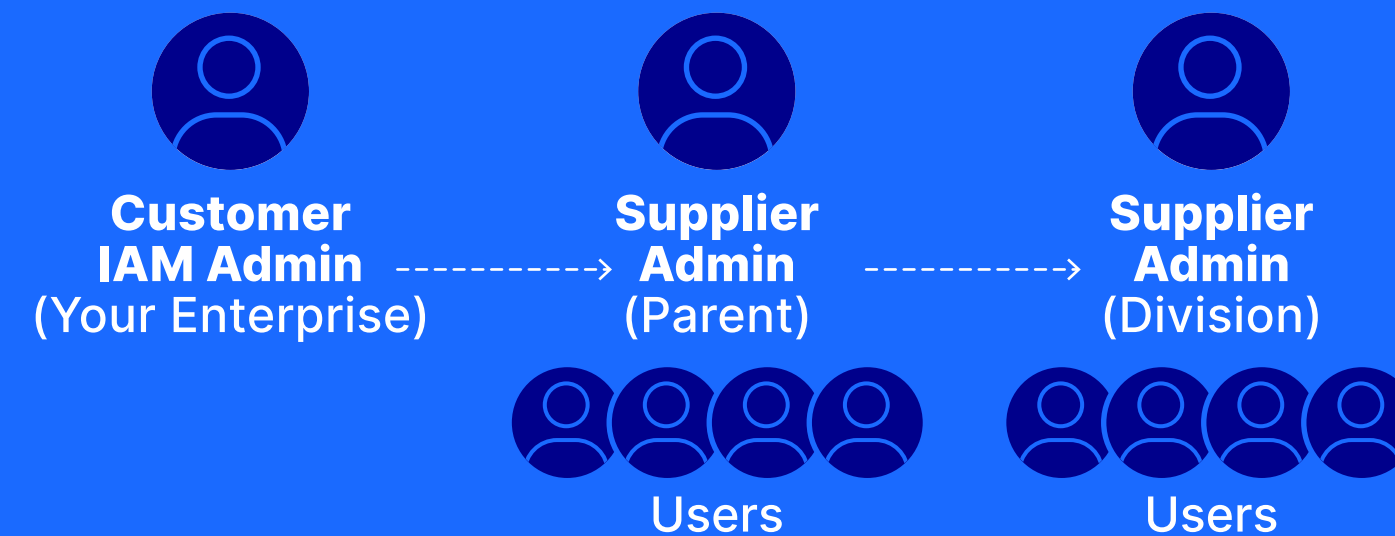

Gain visibility into supplier changes

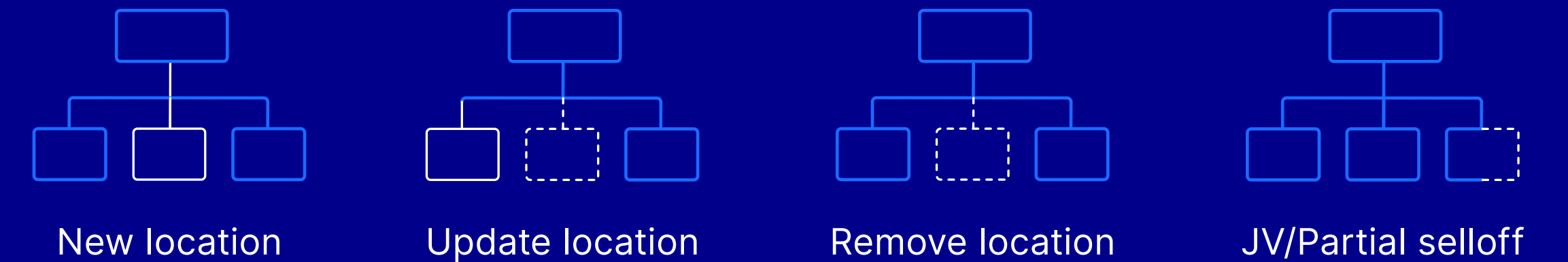

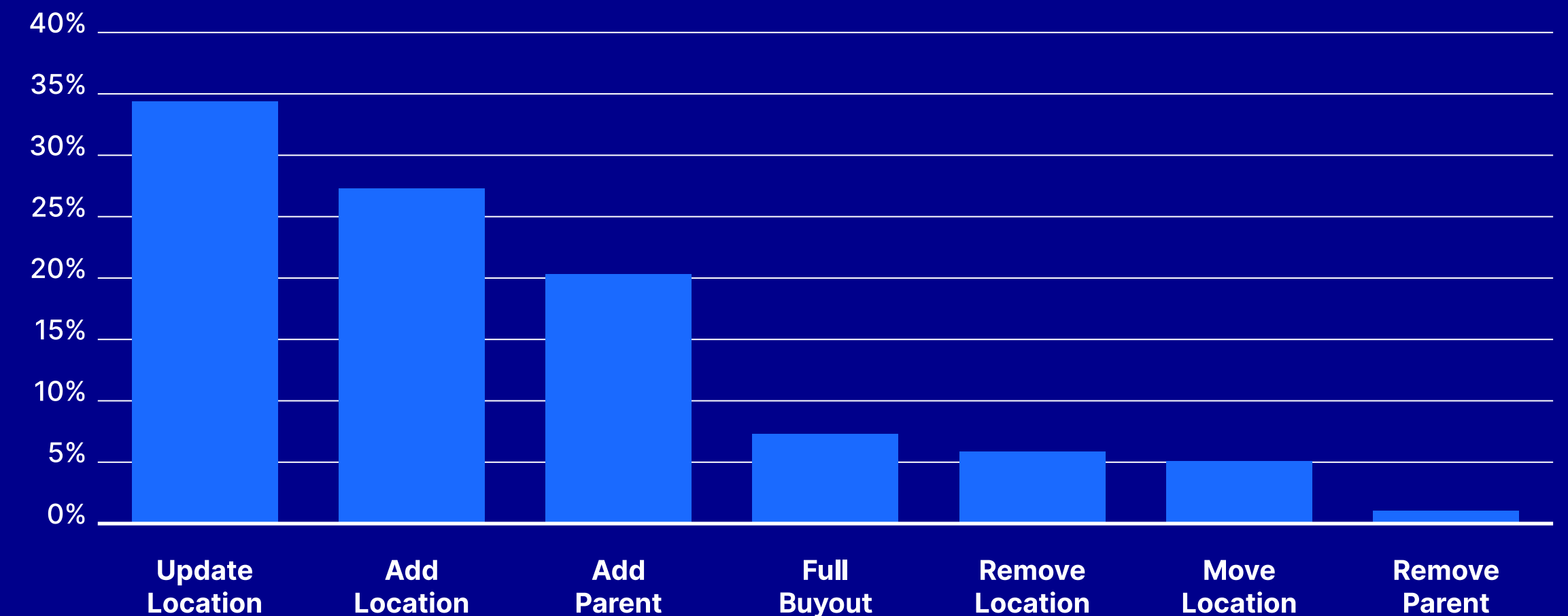

Automated/Assisted master data changes*

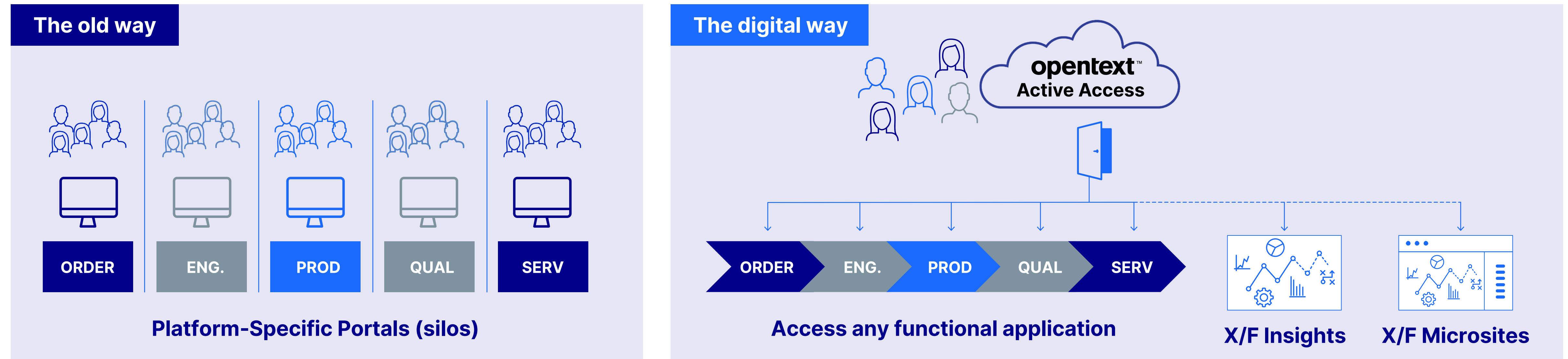


*Global automotive manufacturer. One-year sample based on ≈18,000 changes

Cross-functional collaboration

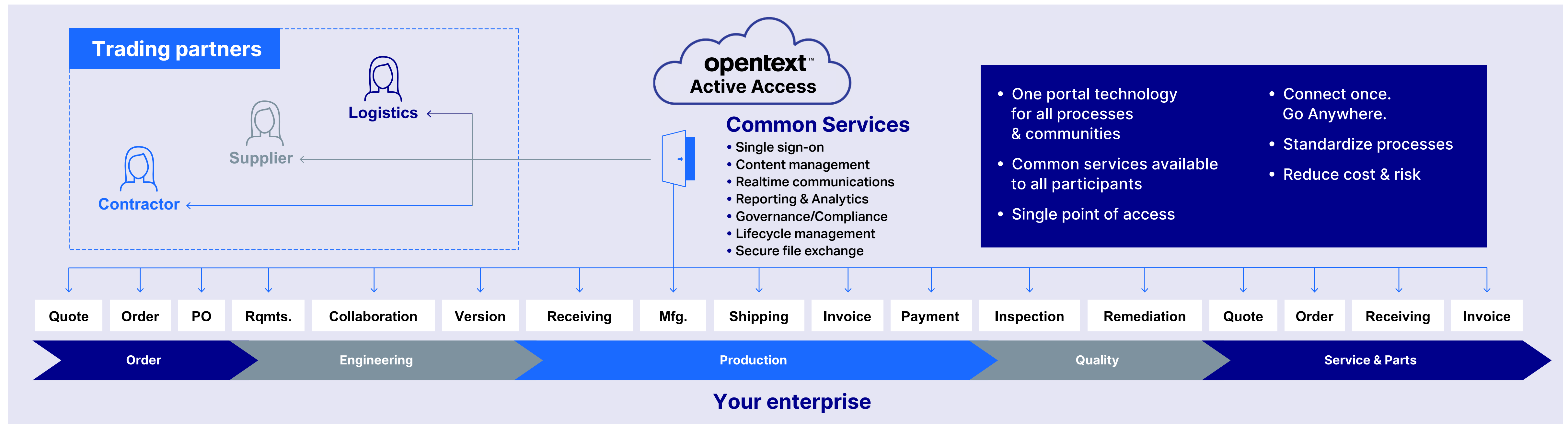

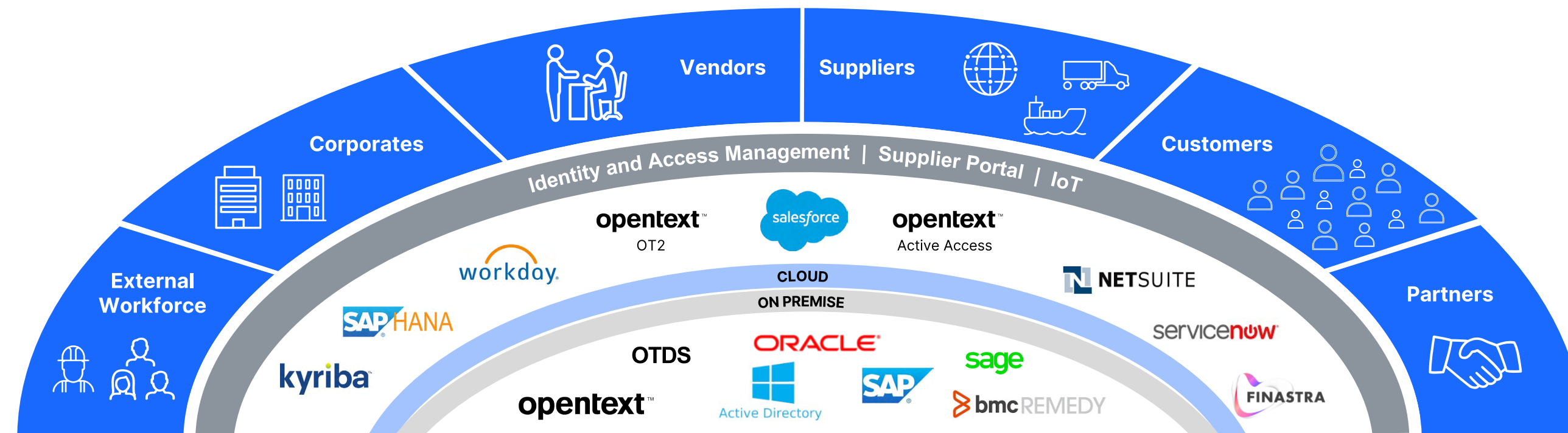
Bringing it all together
